Recently we watched a Story Keepers DVD that helped us understand Communion and another week we made Praise Flags.

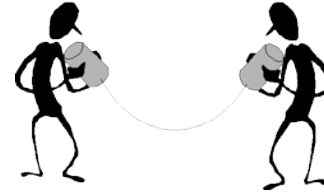


FAMILY SERVICE
