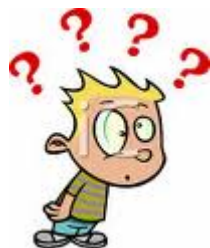


FUNDRAISING PROGRAMME

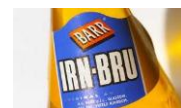
A Taste of Europe
