

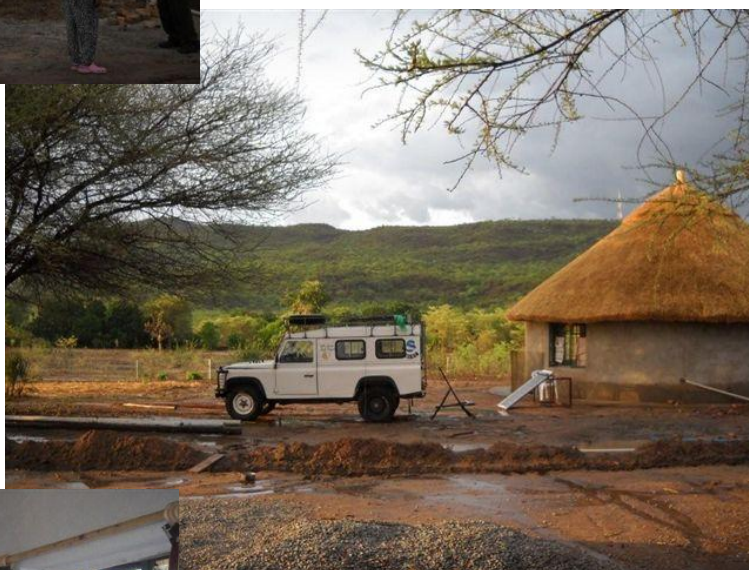


VICKY'S NEW HOUSE IN ZIMBABWE

Polmont Old Parish Church supports the work of Vicky Graham, a missionary who works in the remote and undeveloped Siabuwa area of Zimbabwe spreading the word of God to the Tonga people who live there. Vicky is also a trained nurse who does an incredible job ministering to the medical needs of the people who live around Siabuwa.

During 2011, a house was built for Vicky. It is a rondavel with a 5 metre circumference and has a thatched roof. It has 2 bedrooms, a bathroom and an open kitchen/lounge.

There were many challenges during the building of her house, , from sourcing supplies to getting them up here, to laying the foundations etc.



You will recall that members of Polmont Old collected some money to send to Vicky as a house-warming gift.

The sum of **£70.00** was donated, which was used to purchase curtains for her home.

We in Polmont Old support two mission projects, of which this is one. Funds are raised through various events and split between the two projects.

Eg. Half of the money raised recently from the Missions Christmas Gift Table has been sent out to support Vicky's medical work among the Tonga. It will be used to purchase medicines and equipment to assist in her missionary work.
